# Priestly Fraternity of Saint Peter

Fraternitas Sacerdotalis Sancti Petri (FSSP).

Who Are We? The Priestly Fraternity of St. Peter is a Clerical Society of Apostolic Life of Pontifical right, that is, a community of Roman Catholic priests who work together for a common mission in the world. The mission of the Fraternity is two-fold: the formation and sanctification of priests; and the pastoral care of the faithful, centered upon the traditional prayers and sacramental forms so loved by the Saints and so highly prized by the Church.

The Fraternity was founded under the authority of the Holy See on July 18, 1988 by twelve priests and a score of seminarians. Shortly after the Fraternity's foundation the bishop of Augsburg, at Cardinal Ratzinger's request, granted the Fraternity a Marian shrin8e in Bavaria that now houses one of the Fraternity's seminaries. At present the FSSP has more than 110 seminarians and 200 priests working in a dozen countries. The FSSP came to Australia in March, 2000 and has been invited by the bishops to work in the dioceses of Sydney, Canberra, Parramatta and Adelaide. Additionally, our house in Christchurch, NZ, also falls within the jurisdiction of the Southern Cross region.
